

Our first celebration was held on February 1, 2019, in a grand gala at the Hyatt Aventine Hotel in La Jolla. The date was fitting because the San Diego Regional Center opened its doors on February 1, 1969. The celebration at the Hyatt could not have been possible without the support and assistance of service provider agencies in San Diego and Imperial counties. We thank our service provider partners for their help and, more importantly, for what they do to support the people we serve.

We also had 50th Anniversary celebrations associated with each our five office locations. All of the celebrations

brought together the people we serve, their families, service providers, regional center staff, and many other community partners. There were more than 600 celebrants at our celebration in La Jolla, and we estimate that more than 500 people attended each of the community celebrations. Our sincere thanks go to all who planned and made the celebrations happen.






# San Diego Regional Center Purchase of Services Fiscal Year 2018-2019








